RANGE SAFETY RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

- (1.) The rules of safe gun handling must be observed at all times.
 - a. Always keep muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
 - b. Always keep finger off the trigger until ready to fire.
 - c. Always keep the action open and gun unloaded until ready to fire.
- (2.) Any shooter will be free of alcoholic beverages for at least eight hours.
- (3.) There is absolutely NO SMOKING in the range area.
- (4.) Firearms may only be handled while in range area. All guns in meeting room area must remain cased or holstered. A holstered/cased gun is considered safe.
- (5.) Shooters must shoot in the lane they are in and from the line only.
- (6.) Targets should be fired at 50' and should not exceed 24" in height.
- (7.) Members are totally responsible for their guest.
- (8.) The remaining rules are posted in the clubhouse and where given to each member in the membership packet upon orientation and will be adhered to.

I have read and understand these Safety and Range rules of the Acushnet Rifle and Pistol Club. I understand that violation of these rules may mean forfeiture of my membership.
